

MCCA Safety Protocols

HEALTHY TEAM MEMBERS



All staff are required to wash hands or use available hand sanitizer before entering studio.



We will conduct daily temperature and health screenings of all staff and faculty upon entering the building. Anyone with a temperature will not be allowed to continue past the front desk.



After leaving studios, staff must wash/sanitize again before re-entry.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT



All staff and faculty will be required to wear face masks when in the building.



Studios and common areas will be deep cleaned daily. Studios will be disinfected between each class using a sanitizing fogger; all barres, pianos, doorknobs, etc will be wiped with disinfectant between each class.



Dressing rooms and waiting areas will be closed until further notice.

ARRIVAL EXPERIENCE



Students will arrive no earlier than 5 minutes before their scheduled class start time. Dancers should already be in dance clothes and will not be allowed to change in the bathroom.



Dancers should bring a small bag containing only their dance shoes and a personal water bottle (labeled). You may bring a snack from home if you have a break.



Dancers will enter the studio and check in with the front desk. Here they will be temperature checked with a contactless thermometer. Anyone with a temperature will not be allowed past the front desk.



The instructor will then give them hand sanitizer and direct them to either marked 6' dance space or 6' spaced sections of the ballet barre.



Parents for students over the age of 6 will not be allowed in the building. One parent, for students 6 and under, may walk their students in, but can not wait in the building during class.



Class times have been adjusted to leave a 15-minute buffer in between for cleaning.

CLASS PROCEDURES



All students will be required to wear masks when inside the building and during class.



Classes will be of a limited size to allow for social distancing and be marked off on the floor to ensure students stay in their safe dance space. Instructors will create combinations with social distancing in mind.



Instructors will use verbal cues and maintain a safe distance from all dancers.

OTHER PROCEDURES



If a dancer leaves the studio to use the restroom, they will be required to wash hands and use available hand sanitizer before reentering the studio.



If a student has a break they will stay in their assigned spots to eat any snacks, or wait until the beginning of the next class. All snacks must be brought from home.



There will be no transactions allowed at our front desk.



Parents must pick up dancers as soon as class ends as the students will not be allowed to stay in the building once their class has been completed.
